What happens when warning signs are missed, voices are not heard, and information is not joined together in time?

Katie's death was ruled a suicide; seven months later a man was charged with her murder. Danielle's death was recorded as suicide within fifty-five minutes. Both families were right to ask questions. Both investigations were later found to have fallen short.

ONE ASK

When a domestic abuse victim dies suddenly, look before you decide.

Treat the death as suspicious from the first minute. Preserve the scene. A forensic post-mortem and a senior investigating officer. No cause of death declared at the door.

In Danielle's name. In Katie's name. Launching 26 February 2027.
